Scholars will be paid half of the scholarship monies (\$1,250) at the start of the 2024-2025 academic school year with the requirement to maintain a 3.0 GPA in the fall semester in order to earn the second half (\$1,250) in the spring semester. Scholarships will only be awarded to recipients enrolled in 12 or more credit hours per semester. Recipients will have the opportunity to apply for renewal of this scholarship during spring 2025 for their remaining three academic years.

**CRITERIA:**

1. High school senior living in the greater Kansas City area (Johnson, Miami or Wyandotte counties in Kansas; Jackson, Cass, Clay or Platte counties in Missouri).
2. Must be admitted to Kansas State University and have completed the general scholarship application (due Dec.1).
3. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a weighted or un-weighted scale.
4. Complete the following application to include biographical information, essay, activities, jobs and special recognition. **Please do not include your name, hometown or high school name except for within the below biographical information.** Grading is done anonymously without knowledge of where student lives or attends high school.
