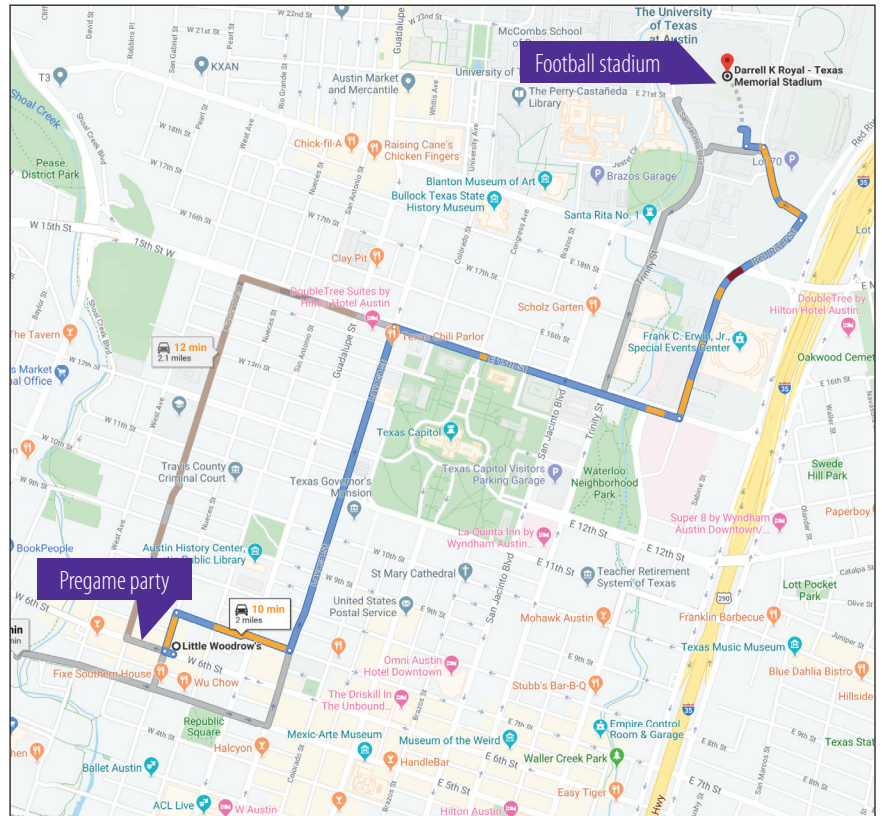

PARKING INFORMATION

Parking Guidelines

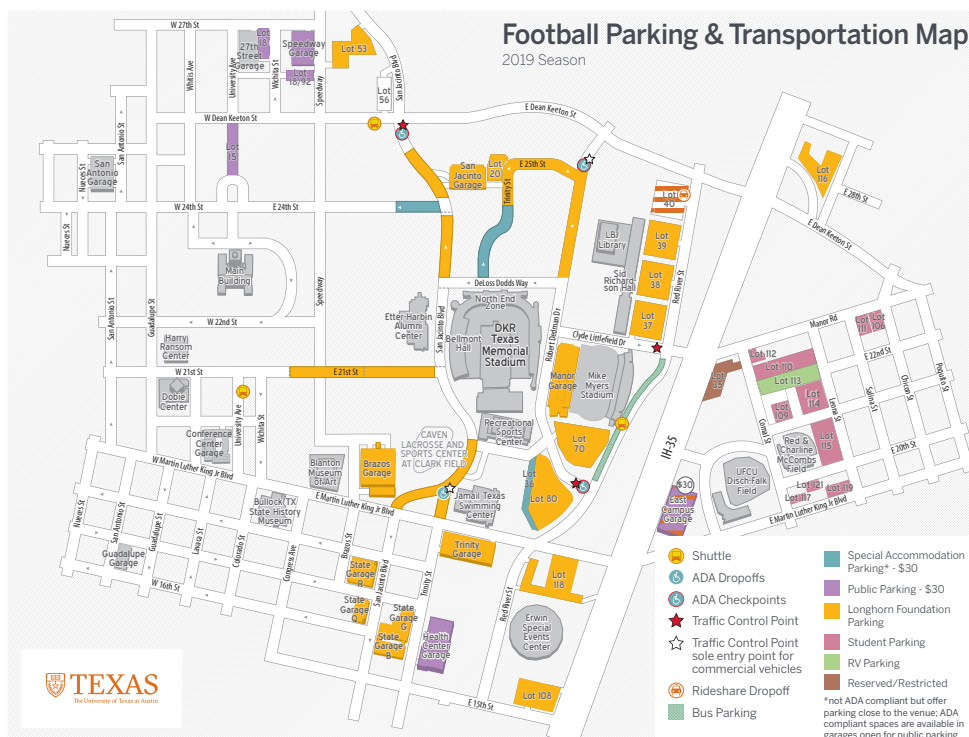
Public parking is available for purchase before the game online at <https://parking.utexas.edu/parking/event/football2019>

The following garages will offer game day parking for \$30 starting five hours before game time:

- Health Center Garage (HCG) at Trinity and 15th Street
- Speedway Garage (SWG) at Speedway and 27th Street
- East Campus Garage (ECG) at IH35 Frontage Road and Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

If online event parking is not sold out, the following UT surface parking lots will be available for public parking for a \$30 fee (credit card only) starting at 7 a.m.:

- Lot 15
- Lot 18
- Lot 92

ADA Parking

ADA parking spaces are compliant with the law. They may or may not be close to the venue of choice. Special Accommodation Parking spaces are not compliant with the law. These spaces are conveniently located closer to the venue.

Convenience parking is available at \$30 per vehicle on a first-come, first-served basis in the following locations starting at 7 a.m.:

- 24th Street between San Jacinto and Speedway - only accessible from the San Jacinto & Dean Keeton Checkpoint
- Lot 36 - Red River & Dedman Checkpoint
- Trinity St near Deloss Dodds Way - Dedman & Dean Keeton Checkpoint

To access Special Accommodation Parking, a person with an ADA state placard or license plate MUST be in the vehicle and have driver's license or registration available to guard for verification.

Special Accommodation Parking is not ADA compliant but they do offer parking close to the venue that fans may

find helpful. ADA compliant spaces are available in garages open for public parking on game day.

ADA Accommodations

Fan Services offers a shuttle service specifically for fans who may be mobility, hearing or visually impaired. Fan Services shuttles at football run five designated routes, associated with five specific gate locations — Gates 1, 7, 16, and 27.

In addition, a stadium loop shuttle rotates between all gates during postgame cart service. This shuttle service exclusively provides service to fans who may have a mobility, hearing or visual impairment.

Gameday Shuttle

Longhorns Express will pick up fans at two locations:

- Barton Creek Mall (2901 S. Capital of Texas Hwy.): The Barton Creek Mall route drops off and picks up along the west curb line of Red River St between Littlefield and Dedman

- Intramural Fields (51st St. and Guadalupe): The IF route drops off and picks up at the corner of Dean Keeton and San Jacinto

Both shuttles begin service 2 1/2 hours prior to kickoff. Transportation to DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium stops after kickoff.

Shuttles begin returning passengers to the remote lots at the beginning of the 4th quarter. The last shuttle departs the stadium one hour after the game ends. There will be no refunds processed after purchase.

Cost for the Longhorns Express is \$10 per person; children 12 and under may ride free.

Tickets may be purchased in advance online via the Longhorns Express website. They are also available on site (cash only) at the park and ride facilities.

Code of Conduct

Texas Athletics is committed to maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all fans, staff, players and coaches. To help us provide this first-class environment, we ask that all patrons and attendees follow these guidelines:

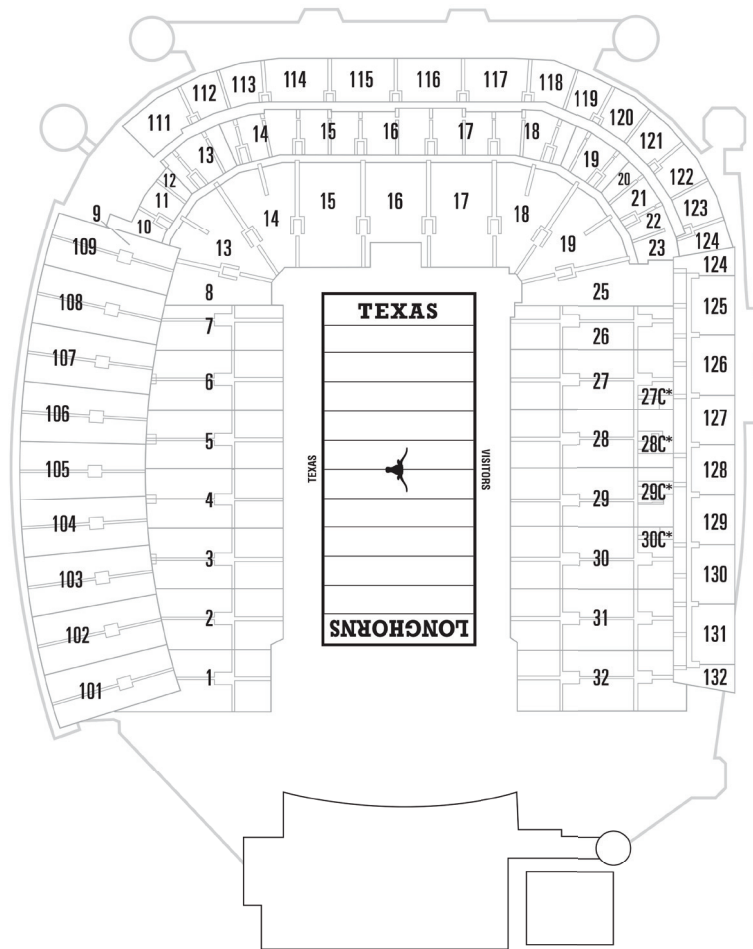
- Contribute to making the environment of Texas Athletics the very best by upholding the spirit of collegiate athletics.
- Ensure all fans are treated in a consistent, professional and polite way by all staff and team personnel.
- Support our teams in a positive manner while treating visiting fans, teams and officials with dignity and respect.
- Promote an environment that minimizes disruption, creates a safe atmosphere for all, prevents interference with the game and ensures the enjoyment of the game for everyone.
- Refrain from using foul or abusive language or inappropriate gestures or attire.
- Be responsible when consuming alcoholic beverages. Impairment, intoxication, underage consumption and unruly behavior will be addressed immediately.
- Sit only in the seat designated on your ticket and be prepared to present the ticket, if requested.
- Acknowledge that The University of Texas at Austin is a tobacco-free campus, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco.
- Comply with emergency messages, emergency procedures and requests from staff concerning the facility and gameday operations.

Refusal to adhere to the guidelines may result in ejection from the facility, without refund. Violation of laws or city ordinances may result in arrest and prosecution. Please report any issues concerning this Code of Conduct to a security guard or event staff personnel, or use the text messaging feature noted below the videoboard.

Tailgating Rules

Tailgating is permitted in parking areas

surrounding DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium. No tents or tailgate set ups are allowed prior to 7 a.m. on gameday. Signage is subject to approval by IMG College/Longhorn Sports Marketing and Texas Athletics. Remember to throw away your trash and to recycle your aluminum, plastic, and glass in the blue recyclable bags which are available in the tailgate lots. Texas Athletics and UT Landscaping will dispose of bags left tied up at your tailgating location.

Prohibited Items

- Artificial noisemakers
- Large bags (see Clear bag policy)
- Banners, flags, flag poles, selfie sticks, signs, umbrellas, etc.
- Cameras with detachable lenses greater than 10", GoPros, video cameras and tripods
- Coolers
- Explosive and flammable materials,

disabling chemicals and other dangerous items

- Food
- Snacks needed for medical purposes are allowed.
- Items deemed a safety hazard or annoyance (Frisbees, balloons, projectiles, laser pointers, fireworks, firearms, weapons, etc.)
- Outside beverages or beverage containers, including sealed or empty water bottles
- Pets (except service dogs)
- Only service dogs are allowed into the stadium. Any other type of animal is not permitted. The service dog should be wearing identifiable attire and be harnessed or tethered in some fashion.
- Strollers
- Tobacco products (See smoking and tobacco policy on UTexas.edu)
- Weapons
