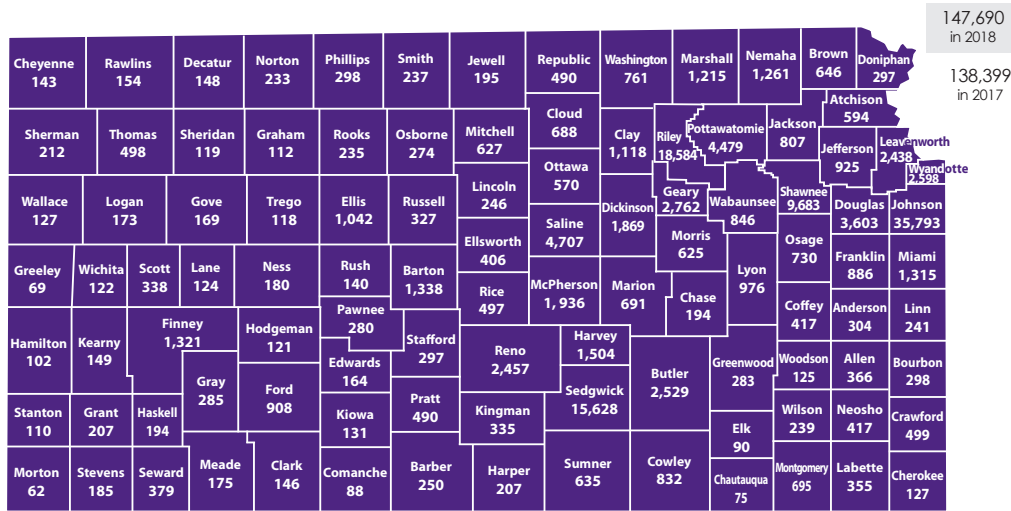

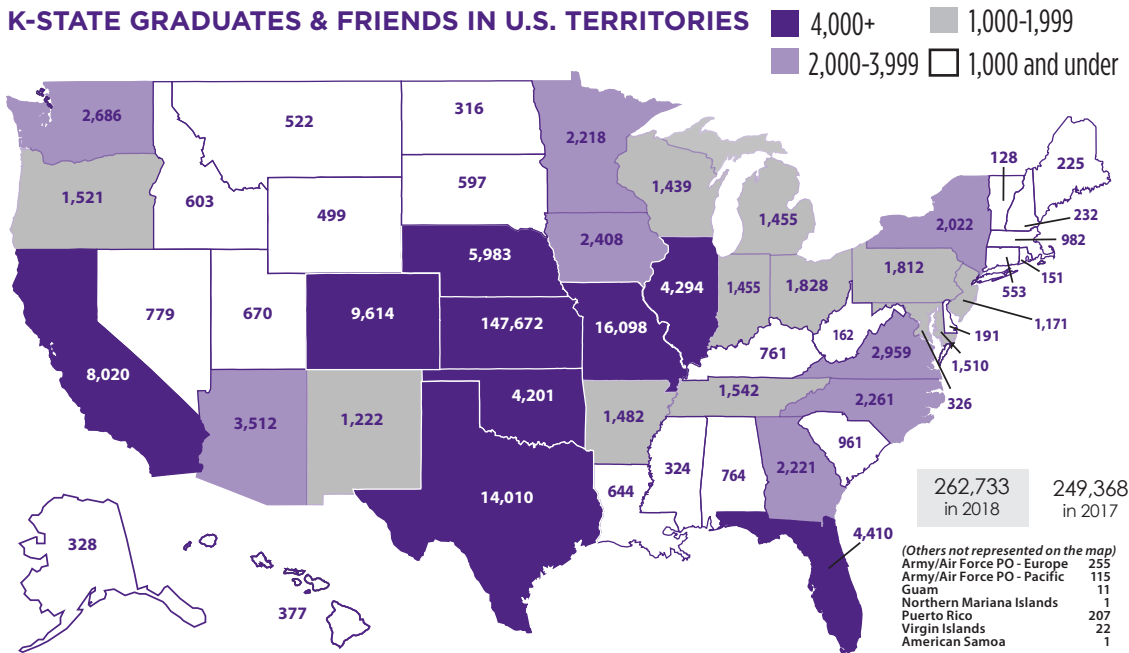

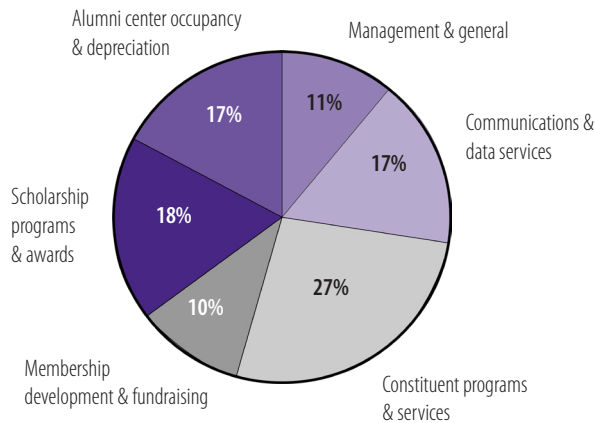

Revenues

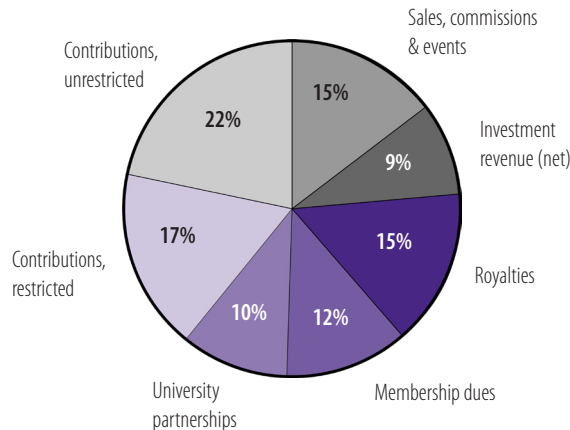
