Job Description: The Associate Director of Alumni Programs directs all in-state and out-ofstate alumni club events including activities with the Kansas City and Wichita Steering committees. Assists the K-State Athletics Department with planning and promoting Catbacker Club events and the Jr. Wildcat Program. Serves as advisor for K-State Student Ambassadors throughout their one-year term.

Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Directs all Association in-state and out of state club activities including scheduling and promotions.
- 2. Collaborates with the athletic department on planning and promoting all Catbacker Club events.
- 3. Responsible for the Wichita Wine dinner and North Texas Boots & BBQ signature events.
- 4. Works with the athletic department in planning and implementing the Jr. Wildcat Program.
- 5. Directs Kansas City and Wichita Club activities and serves as the chair of the Kansas City and Wichita Alumni Steering committees
- 6. Serves as advisor for the K-State Student Ambassadors and coordinates their selection each fall.
- 7. Works with the President's office to plan alumni engagement opportunities around the President's travel schedule.
- 8. Plans the Homecoming pep rally with the assistance of the Student Homecoming Committee.
- 9. Responsible for creating and managing budget for assigned program areas.
- 10. Represents the Association at Association, university and community activities in a professional manner.
- 11. Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: A bachelor's degree is required with a preference in Marketing or Public Relations. A self-starter with strong writing, speaking and organizational skills. Event planning and experience working with volunteers is preferred. A minimum of two years work experience in an area relevant to the position required. Extensive travel is required with some overnight and weekend stay necessary.

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
