

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Athens, Greece.

Day 2 | Athens, Greece

Transfer To the NJV Athens Plaza Hotel.

Free Time: Make your own plans for the rest of the day. The hotel is conveniently located on Syntagma Square. At the nearby Greek Parliament building, watch the changing of the guard every hour on the hour. In the Plaka, take an evening stroll, or *volta*, a social event many Greeks enjoy with family and friends when the sun goes down.

Start off your Greek adventure with your fellow travelers at tonight's Welcome Dinner.

Day 3 | Athens

Discovery: *Athens.* Explore the birthplace of democracy and Western philosophy, theater and architecture. See Athens Academy, the University of Athens and the National Library, the city's famous trio of neoclassical buildings. Ascend the Acropolis and admire the gleaming Parthenon dedicated to the goddess Athena. At the Acropolis Museum, examine treasures and gaze down through glass flooring to see the ruins of an ancient neighborhood.

Savor a lunch of delectable local specialties.

Free Time: Head off to explore Athens!

Day 4 | Poros

Embark a hydrofoil to the island of Poros.

Discovery: *Poros Town.* Stroll along the waterfront past whitewashed homes to the Archaeological Museum of Poros for a tour.

Enrichment: *Meet the People.* Enjoy a traditional lunch with island residents at a local taverna and learn about life in Greece.

Check in to the New Aegli Hotel.

Enrichment: *Classical Greece.* Delve into ancient Greece's impact on the Western world.

Gather tonight for a special "Welcome to Poros" Reception and Dinner.

Day 5 | **Mycenae**

Discovery: *Mycenae.* Follow your guide through the fortified citadel of Mycenae, the once mighty Bronze Age kingdom. A wealthy city which flourished in the second millennium B.C., Mycenae was a great naval power that extended Mycenaean influence throughout the Mediterranean and into Asia Minor. According to legend, it was home to Agamemnon, the king who conquered Troy.

Discovery: *Greek Wine.* Relax over lunch and sample local vintages at a winery.

Enrichment: *Greek History.* Examine key periods and influential figures related to the foundation of the modern-day republic.

Day 6 | **Hydra**

This morning, take a water taxi to the port and catch a hydrofoil to the nearby island of Hydra.

Discovery: *Hydra.* Cruise to Hydra, gem of the Saronic Gulf. Free of cars, the island is celebrated for its exquisite harbor and superb stone architecture. Visit the National Archives for a glimpse into the 18th- and 19th-century history of both Hydra and Greece. Afterward, enjoy some time for lunch and sightseeing on





your own. Take the hydrofoil back to Poros and a water taxi to the hotel.

Enrichment: *Greek Art.* Learn how the visual arts in Greece reflect the culture and beliefs of its people throughout history.

Sit down for a delicious dinner tonight in town.

Day 7 | Epidaurus | Nafplio

Discovery: *Epidaurus.* Tucked amid pinecovered hills, Epidaurus is renowned for its ancient theater, one of the main monuments of the Sanctuary of Asklepios. Built in the fourth

century B.C., the well-preserved theater is still in use today. The classical Greek structure seats up to 14,000 people and has incredible acoustics; a coin dropped in the center of the theater can be heard in the highest seat. After your tour, break for lunch in the area.

Discovery: *Nafplio.* Situated on a rocky peninsula that juts into the Argolic Gulf, Nafplio briefly was the first capital of Greece during the War of Independence after Greek forces wrested it from Ottoman control in 1822. On a guided walk along the medieval Old Town's narrow lanes, take in its unique ambience as you pass by mansions adorned with Turkish fountains and bougainvillea trees. Admire the prominent profile of hilltop Palamidi Castle, a fortress built by the Venetians in the early 1700s. Explore on your own afterward.

Free Time: Make your own plans this evening upon your return to Poros.

Day 8 | Poros

Enrichment: Contemporary Greece.

Discover how modern attitudes and lifestyles reflect ancient customs and traditions.

Free Time: Set your own fun agenda today! Perhaps linger on one of the many beaches or visit the shops and friendly tavernas.


