DAY 1: PORT COLBORNE, CANADA

Located between Lake Michigan and Lake Huron, this national historic landmark is steeped in Victorian-era charm. Horse-drawn carriages navigate this small island, which has a no-car policy. Gain insight into the island's compelling history at Michigan's oldest building, Fort Mackinac. Experience the imposing stone walls and cannons of this impressive fort, built atop a cliff by British soldiers in 1780.

DAY 7: GREEN BAY, WISCONSIN

Green Bay is Wisconsin's oldest settlement and the smallest American city to host a National Football League team. The city is home to a wide array of cultural attractions, including the Tarlton Theater, the National Railroad Museum, the Green Bay Botanical Garden, and the Cofrin Memorial Arboretum, which hosts six miles of public hiking trails.

DAY 8: MUSKEGON, MICHIGAN

With an array of outdoor parks, twenty-six miles of sandy beaches, and opportunities for upscale dining, Muskegon has something for everyone. Spend time here at the USS *LST 393* Veterans Museum or tour the USS *Silversides* to get a look at what it was like to sail in an old-fashioned submarine.
