## Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Paris, France.

## Day 2 | Paris, France | Honfleur

Upon arrival, transfer to Honfleur, and check in to the Mercure Honfleur Hotel.

This evening, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception in the hotel, then enjoy a Welcome Dinner at a restaurant in town.

## Day 3 | Honfleur

**Discovery:** *Historic Honfleur.* Get to know this quintessential French port town that has captivated artists for centuries. Soak up the maritime ambience of its picture-perfect, 17th-century Vieux Bassin, or old harbor, located where the Seine River meets the English Channel. Stroll along the colorful harbor and narrow side streets to see landmarks like the wooden Church of Sainte-Cathérine crafted by 15th-century shipbuilders.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant.

**Free Time:** Explore Honfleur at your leisure.

## Day 4 | Arromanches | Omaha Beach | Normandy American Cemetery | Pointe du Hoc

**Enrichment:** *D-Day and the Battle of Normandy.* Understand the critical role that Normandy played during this crucial period of the Allied war effort.

**Discovery:** *D-Day and the Battle of* **Normandy.** In Arromanches, see the site of one of the offshore mulberry harbors and tour

the museum. A remarkable feat of engineering, these artificial floating harbors cleverly enabled the Allies to funnel enormous resources into France to wage war against Hitler.

Break for lunch in Arromanches.

Then, as you walk along Omaha Beach and see the memorial, contemplate the extraordinary bravery of the Allied landing forces, who valiantly advanced under devastating fire across the heavily fortified shoreline to overcome German troops.

In Colleville-sur-Mer, pay a poignant visit to the Normandy American Cemetery set on a beautiful bluff overlooking Omaha Beach, which contains 9,385 graves of Americans who died in the invasion and subsequent battles, as well as a tranquil memorial garden honoring those missing in action.

Finally, visit Pointe du Hoc, where U.S. Rangers courageously scaled 100-foot cliffs to destroy German artillery. Learn about this treacherous mission from your guide and examine a German defensive emplacement.

## Day 5 | Giverny | Rouen

Discovery: Giverny and Rouen. Raised in Normandy, Claude Monet lived in his cheerful, green-shuttered home in Giverny from 1883 to 1926. Admire the enchanting gardens that endlessly inspired him and visit the studio where he painted his "Water Lilies" series. Continue to the Musée des Impressionnismes Giverny, dedicated to impressionism's history. After viewing the museum's collection, enjoy lunch on your own. Depart Giverny for Rouen, renowned for



## Normandy & D-Day

"You are about to embark upon the Great Crusade, toward which we have striven these many months. The eyes of the world are upon you. The hopes and prayers of liberty-loving people everywhere march with you."

With General Dwight D. Eisenhower's inspiring message, one of history's largest and most complex military invasions was launched on June 6, 1944. More than 155,000 Allied forces arrived by air and sea and faced fierce resistance. The cost was high, with the Allies sustaining thousands of casualties, but they gradually succeeded in securing the beaches and later advanced inland to liberate Paris. D-Day will be remembered forever as the pivotal moment of World War II when the tide began to turn against Nazi Germany.

its medieval architecture. See the magnificent Rouen Cathedral, which Monet famously captured in different lights; the wealth of half-timbered houses; and the ornate astronomical clock known as Le Gros Horloge. Hear the haunting story of Joan of Arc, who was martyred in the town square in 1431.

This evening, dine with your fellow travelers at a quaint restaurant in Honfleur.

## Day 6 | Mont-Saint-Michel

**Discovery:** Le Mont-Saint-Michel. With one glimpse of Mont-Saint-Michel's silhouette rising above the surrounding flat sands, you'll know why this UNESCO World Heritage site is considered a wonder of the Western world. On a guided tour, explore this fascinating granite island that has served as a fortress, monastery and prison, and visit the serene

abbey and church that have drawn pilgrims for centuries. If you'd like, walk along the ramparts to admire the panoramic vistas.

## Day 7 | Honfleur

**Free Time:** The day is yours to plan! Visit nearby museums, stroll along the sea walls or take in the local scene from a waterfront café.

## Enrichment: The French Resistance.

Delve into the origins of the Resistance, its leaders and the heroic efforts of the French patriots who fought to liberate their country.

## Day 8 | Caen | Bayeux

**Discovery:** Le Mémorial de Caen. Visit the award-winning Caen Memorial Museum and gain intriguing insights about World War II, D-Day and the Battle of Normandy through its engrossing exhibits, photos and videos.

Normandy's famous apple cider brandy is among the world's finest brandies. Visit an estate that distills Calvados from the apples grown on its 42 acres of orchards and learn about the production process. Sip a glass of smooth Calvados and relax over lunch.

**Discovery:** Bayeux. View the 11th-century Bayeux Tapestry, a finely stitched historic artifact nearly 230 feet long, embroidered with more than 50 scenes related to the Norman conquest of England and the Battle of Hastings in 1066. Later, admire the Gothic details of Bayeux's Notre Dame cathedral.
