GENERAL RULES



-  **NO ALCOHOL OR INTOXICANTS.** This includes bringing or using alcohol at an event or attending an event under the influence of alcohol. This rule also applies to any other intoxicant. Intoxicants will not be tolerated at any Homecoming events and activities including practices, rehearsals and preparations for any Homecoming related activities. Any member of your group violating this rule during Homecoming events and activities will cause your entire group to be disqualified from all Homecoming competitions.
-  **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING.** K-State campus is non-smoking and all event locations off campus will be non-smoking.
-  **IN ALL COMPETITIONS, THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL. QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS REGARDING THE HOMECOMING COMPETITION SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION.**
-  The K-State Homecoming committee reserves the right to remove, clean or stop any performance that is deemed off-theme or unsuitable.
-  **THE HOMECOMING COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DEDUCT POINTS FROM ANY GROUP'S EVENT SCORE FOR ANY REASON IT DEEMS NECESSARY.** Reasons for point deductions include, but are not limited to: false expense reports, failure to follow rules, and failure to turn in required documents. In most cases, the committee will deduct five points from an event total, but that remains at the discretion of the committee.

For example: If the Homecoming Committee determined an aspect of your float was excluded from the expense report, your organization may have placed third with a score of 88, but the five-point deduction would make your float score 83. The fifth-place group finished with a score of 84. Your organization would still receive participation points, but your group would have lost its placing and the points for placing.
